Clean Air Zone temporary diversion route

For access to Whitehouse Lane, Whitehouse Street,
Princess Street or Windmill Farm business and industrial areas,
vehicles which do not meet Clean Air Zone emission standards
should follow the diversion route shown below.





Malago Road – Clean Air Zone diversion route

Malago Road will be closed northbound until summer 2024 (southbound traffic is still permitted during the construction period).

Any vehicles entering the Whitehouse Lane, Whitehouse Street, Princess Street or Windmill Farm business and industrial areas that do not meet Bristol's **Clean Air Zone** emission standards would be charged if they follow the current diversion route in place.

If you are driving a vehicle which does not meet Clean Air Zone emission standards, we are providing an alternative diversion route which is not in the zone and so will not incur a charge.

Please follow the exact route indicated on the plan (starting at Dean Lane). Follow diversion signs for: "Whitehouse Lane/Whitehouse Street industrial areas".

To ensure access to this diversion route, part of a traffic island will be removed on Coronation Road, allowing vehicles to turn right into New Charlotte Street.

This diversion will be available from Monday 28 November 2022.
